CALL FOR ENTRY

DEADLINE: Friday, March 6, 2015

The Carnegie Craft Juried Biennial Exhibition is an event that features a wide range of talent from Ontario-based craft practitioners.

Carnegie Craft 2015 is open to both emerging and established professional craftspeople. Material categories that will be considered by the jury include ceramic, wood, textile, metal, glass and mixed media. This is a great opportunity to exhibit your work, and to be considered for one of eight awards!

During the evening of the opening reception on Friday, April 10 th, winners of the following awards will be announced: \$1,000 for Best in Show, two \$500 Awards of Excellence, and five media-specific awards.

The Carnegie Gallery was established in 1980 as a non-profit artist- run gallery and shop, and is situated in the heart of Dundas, Ontario. The Gallery is mandated to encourage the appreciation and production of Canadian art and artists, in both visual art and craft.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Applicants must be residents of Ontario.
- 2. All works submitted must be of original design, and executed solely by the applicant within the last 24 months.
- 3. Work assembled from commercial kits or patterns will not be accepted.
- 4. Each applicant may submit up to three (3) entries. A pair or set of multiples counts as a single item.
- 5. Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- 6. No entry may be withdrawn once it has been chosen by the jury for exhibition, and all works must remain on display for the duration of the show. The jurors' decision is final.
- 7. Work must be submitted in ready to hang/display condition, and specific display support materials must be supplied by the applicant where required.
- 8. Submissions must include: a completed call for entry form, artist statement, curriculum vitae, as well as digital images of the work to be reviewed.
- 9. Works submitted must be the works shown in the photographs. All works are subject to inspection upon arrival for breakage. Carnegie Craft reserves the right to reject any submissions that are different from that portrayed in the images submitted.
- 10. Submissions must be accompanied by the call for entry fee.

- 11. The submission of any entry gives permission to the Carnegie Gallery to reproduce and use any image submitted for publicity or archival purposes, including use on its website.
- 12. The applicant's signature on the entry form indicates acceptance of the terms of *Carnegie Craft* 2015 as outlined in this document.
- 13. Prizes will be awarded at the jurors' discretion.

EXHIBITION INFORMATION

- 1. The applicant is responsible for insuring their own work.
- 2. Works accepted for exhibition will be delivered/shipped to the Carnegie Gallery at the exhibitor's expense by 5:00 pm on Friday, March 27, 2015.
- 3. While all due care will be taken, the Carnegie Gallery is not responsible for any damages arising during the exhibition nor in the return of those shipped works requiring return shipping. Shipped works will be returned in the original packaging at the exhibitor's expense.
- 4. Artists who are picking up work directly from the gallery must do so on Tuesday, April 28 between 10:00 am and 2:00 pm
- 5. Due to a lack of storage space, artists delivering accepted pieces in person must retain all packing materials at the time of delivery.
- 6. The Carnegie Gallery will not be responsible for work that is not picked up by 2:00 pm on April 28, 2015.
- 7. All works must be available for sale. A commission of 40% will be retained on all sales.

ENTRY FEES

Each entry is \$20 for a total of up to three entries (\$60).

Entry fees are not refundable.

Entries must be accompanied by an entry form and fee payable to the Carnegie Gallery, 10 King St West, Dundas, ON L9H 1T7

TIMELINE & ENTRY PROCESS

Carnegie Craft 2015 will be juried by digital images (see image requirements below). Applications can be delivered by mail or in person to The Carnegie Gallery, 10 King St. West, Dundas, ON L9H 1T7

Deadline: Friday, March 6, 2015

Jury Selection: All applicants will be notified by email on Friday, March 13, 7:00 pm. **Delivery:** Selected works must arrive at the gallery by Friday, March 27, 2015, 5:00 pm.

Exhibition dates: April 3 – 26, 2015

Opening reception and Awards presentation: Friday, April 10, 7:00 - 9:30 pm

Pick up of all unsold work: Tuesday, April 28, 10:00 am - 2:00 pm

Jurors: Emma Quin, Executive Director, Craft Ontario David Kaye, Director, David Kaye Gallery, Toronto

IMAGE REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Select up to four professional images per work. One of these can be a close-up image. Photograph work on a neutral light background.
- 2. Prepare images by using the following specifications: 72-300 dpi in jpg format and with the longest side equaling or exceeding 1000 pixels. Your image size should be about 1MB in size each and not exceeding 5 MB.
- 3. Format your image file names without spaces or capitalization. The format should be as follows: the first 3 letters of your first name followed by the first 3 letters of your last name, then underscore "_", and finally the number of the image from 01-12.

Eg. – Jane Smith: jansmi_01.jpg jansmi_02.jpg

- 4. Burn all images on a CD-ROM or DVD. Do not write any information on the actual image. Please write your name on the actual CD/DVD along with the title Carnegie Craft 2015.
- 5. Include an image list (pdf or doc format) that identifies each digital image on your CD/DVD.
